



Tournament Checklist

To avoid disappointment, apply for your tournaments as early as possible.

	<p>Tournament Application - Apply for tournament (must be sanctioned by ODMHA, Hockey Canada, or Hockey USA).</p>
	<p>Team Roster - Get copy of official team roster from OMHA registrar and make a few copies.</p>
	<p>Payment - by cheque or bank draft. If intending to use a post-dated cheque, verify acceptability of such with Tournament Director <u>prior</u> to forwarding</p>
	<p>Logistics - Get arena names and locations from tournament committee. Prepare map and directions (ref. www.arenamaps.com) to provide to the team.</p>
	<p>Travel Permit - If traveling out of town, print off a travel permit from the ODMHA forms link. This must be signed by your OMHA president and the GHA District Chair.</p>
	<p>U.S Travel Permit - If traveling to the U.S. then a U.S. travel permit is needed. This must be signed by your OMHA president and the GHA District Chair.</p>
	<p>Insurance - For U.S. tournaments you must get your own insurance coverage (Blue Cross etc) or obtain additional team coverage as the league insurance does not cover you outside of Canada.</p>
	<p>Lodging - Book hotel accommodations (ask for a hospitality suite for team parties). It is best to book your accommodations even before you get word that your team has been accepted. The rooms can always be canceled afterwards in your team is denied.</p>
	<p>Tournament schedule, rules, info - Tournament committee will send you the schedule, rules and other info usually two weeks prior to the tournament.</p>
	<p>Skills Competition - Some tournaments have a skills competition and will require you or the coach to assign players for each skill. Leave this for the coach.</p>
